What is the Reflections Program?

The Reflections Program is an arts recognition and achievement program. New Virginia Graduation Requirement for Economics and Personal Finance Starts This Year

Because of legislation passed by the 2010 General Assembly, one additional credit in economics and personal finance must be completed prior to graduation beginning with students enrolled in grade 9 during the 2011-12 academic year.

FCPS has developed a course entitled Economics and Personal Finance to meet the new state requirement which can be taken face-to-face or through the FCPS Online Campus; the online course is available this fall. In addition, two semester courses, AP Microeconomics and AP

Macroeconomics, will meet the state diploma requirement. Further, FCPS is working with local colleges and universities to seek dual enrollment options after school and during the summer in another alternative effort to meet the requirement.

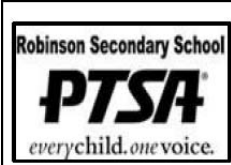

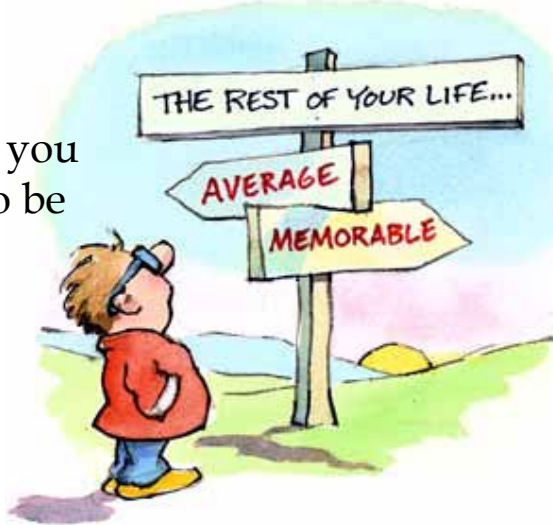
